General Information

1. Reloads meeting ATA specs are permitted for tournament.
2. No refund on entries or change to options will be made within 1/2 hour of the start of the event.
3. Any shooter wanting to re-squad at their discretion will be charged a \$10 re-squad fee. Any shooter missing their squad will be charged a \$10 re-squad fee. No shooter may make up more than 25 targets on the practice traps. If you miss your squad after the 2nd trap is started, you must re-squad. The only exception to the re-squadding fee will be for gun repair. Shooters leaving a squad for gun repair should notify the Trap Line Supervisor.
4. By entering competition, every shooter agrees to abide by all ATA, PTC rules and decisions made by the management of this shoot.
5. Please be at your trap, ready to shoot when your on-deck squad number is posted. Squads will not be allowed to wait for tardy members. (See #4 above).
6. As always, it is the responsibility of the shooter to check the scoreboard to see that all entries are correct. All reports to the ATA and Trap and Field will be reported as it appears on the bulletin board. Trophies and money awards will also be based on this information.
7. The management reserves the right to alter, modify or change any part of this program at their discretion; or reject any entry that disrupts the harmony of the shoot. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated in any form.
8. Shoot-offs for PTC trophies will be carried over to the next like event, and will be managed by PTC.
9. The sale of ammo on the grounds is prohibited: except by approval of PTC. Empty hulls become the property of PTC when they hit the ground.
10. Orange dome targets will be thrown for the competition. White targets may be thrown if shoot-offs carry over into darkness.
11. Targets will be set to ATA standard before each event. No traps will be changed by individual squads.
12. Fees ATA \$2.00 daily. Zone fees \$1.00 per 100 target event, \$2.00 per 200 target event. State fee's will be \$1.00 per 100 target and \$2.00 per 200 event.
